Her parents needed her services she had to leave us in April 2012. Her leaving us was hard for me and for my co-workers.

The struggle-ful search for a teacher like Shristi continued for April, May, June and early July. There were candidates ready to teach daytime, but none to stay at night with the girls. It was a big disappointment. At this juncture also I took the interview of the girls and a new batch was selected. The group came in the hostel and God listened to our prayer. Shristi's vacant place was filled by **Sunita Chakravarty** in mid-July 2012.

Opening was done on July 5, 2012. With their parents, 14 girls joined our Bridge Course. The classes began on July 10, 2012, and along with it began a match between the new girls and the staff. Call it a cricket match or a football match, trying our patience, our skills and our resources. Nothing was less trying than past years. In spite of all our love and tender care, two dropped out in the very first week.

A month later we decided to send all the girls home for four days of their feast, on trial a basis. And to our surprise, some of these girls brought such a nice

Slowly the vehicle came on a right track. Classes have picked up the normal speed. The girls have started loving us, when we feel our energy is exhausted.

A new teacher, **Miss Chandani Kumari**, has joined us because it was too much for one person to be 24 hours with the group.

Mr. Pankaj Kumar from Sacred Heart School Bettiah joined us for part time in the afternoon to teach the girls computer and some games. So we have higher goals than in past.

Do remember us that we all may do better.
